ROMANUS

ROMAN

Romans valued civic duty, honor, and the success of their city and empire above all else.

Weapons and Armor: Roman legionaries favored the gladius, pilum, and scutum for combat, with armor types varying by rank, including Lorica Hamata, Segmentata, and Musculata.

GRAECUS

Clothing: The chiton and himation were staples of Greek attire, crafted from linen or wool. Simplicity in daily wear contrasted with the elaborate decorations for special occasions, complemented by distinctive sandals.

Weapons and Armor: Greek military excellence is epitomized by the hoplite, armed with the dory, xiphos, and aspis. Bronze cuirasses, greaves, and crested helmets were common.

Men often sport full beards and long hair, with both genders displaying intricate tattoos signifying tribal affiliations and personal achievements.

Clothing: Galli wear woolen tunics and trousers, complemented by heavy cloaks to withstand their region's cooler climates. Clothing often features bright colors and complex patterns, reflecting their craftsmanship in textile work.

Weapons and Armor: Known for their long swords and large shields. They favor chainmail for protection, a testament to their metallurgical skills. Warriors adorn their helmets with feathers or horns.

AEGYPTIUS

EGYPTIAN

Clothing: Their clothing primarily consists of light linen garments, such as the kalasiris for women and a simple loincloth or skirt for men, suitable for the hot climate. Higher status individuals often wore more elaborate and finely decorated attire.

Weapons and Armor: Aegyptii soldiers might wield spears, bows, and short swords. Armor was not commonly used, except for shields made from animal hide or wood, prioritizing mobility in the hot climate.

Clothing: Syrian attire is characterized by vibrant tunics and trousers, richly adorned with intricate patterns and accessorized with belts and jewelry, showcasing their wealth and connection to the Silk Road.

Weapons and Armor: While not primarily known as warriors, Syri utilized light spears and bows in defense of their cities. Leather armor and small shields provided protection without hindering their mobility.

Appearance: Hispanus individuals typically have olive to fair skin, with dark hair being predominant. They are well-built, and facial features include strong jawlines and intense, expressive eyes.

Clothing: Their attire consists of tunics and cloaks made from local wool, suitable for the varied climates of the peninsula. Leather sandals or boots were commonly worn.

Weapons and Armor: The falcata, a curved sword unique to the region, is a symbol of Hispanus martial prowess. They also employed javelins and round shields in battle. Armor varied from chainmail for the wealthier warriors to simple leather protections for the common soldier.

Clothing: Parthian clothing was a mix of Persian and Hellenistic styles, featuring silk robes, trousers for riding, and ornate headgear. Their attire was practical for desert climates and horseback riding, yet richly decorated, reflecting their wealth and status.

Weapons and Armor: The Parthi excelled in mounted combat, utilizing composite bows as their primary weapon. They also carried short swords for close combat.

GERMANUS

Clothing: Their attire consisted of simple woolen tunics and trousers, designed for mobility and the harsh climate. Cloaks fastened with brooches were common, providing additional warmth and protection against the elements.

Weapons and Armor: Favored weapons included long swords (spathas), spears, and the seax, a type of knife. Shields were large and wooden, often round, providing defense in skirmishes and battles. Armor was less common, but those who could afford it might wear chainmail or leather for added protection.

Weapons and Armor: Celebrated for their cavalry prowess, they utilize lances and composite bows effectively. They are also known for wearing scale armor, which offers protection in combat without sacrificing mobility.

Weapons and Armor: Armenii warriors favored the use of long spears, swords, and bows. Armor was practical, with leather and metal scale armors being common.

Appearance: Nubians have dark brown to black skin and typically sport tightly coiled hair. They are known for their height and strong, lean physiques, reflecting their adeptness as warriors and hunters.



Clothing: Ethiopian attire consists of garments made from cotton and animal skins, which are richly decorated with beads and metalwork.

Weapons and Armor: Ethiopians when needed wielded spears and short swords. Shields made from animal hide or wood were common for protection.
